1:10 - Review of Activities This Year - Mover: Alex Beaubien

Some examples of all the social activities that happened this year: Mentorship Program, Camping, Skating, Arts and Crafts, Creation of PARSEC, Welcome Back BBQ, Halloween Photo, Winter Trivia Night

Some academic activities that happened this past year: 3 Software Plumbing sessions 13 SPACE talks The industry panel of industry vs. academia over the summer for the first time

Some of the sports activities that were offered this year: Intramural Soccer, cycling, gym, *NEW* bouldering, snorkelling, hiking

Website has been revamped and updated to a newer version of WordPress. Alongside, we trimmed out-of-date content; there is currently less content overall, but the content itself is more applicable. A Constitutional Change Working Group was created and will propose changes later during the AGM (see below).

1:17 - Budget - Mover: Alex Beaubien

The budget comes from two income streams: GSS and the Department. The Department is case-by-case, GSS is a guaranteed grant for which we apply in April (GSS Fiscal Year start), along with the possibility of a top-up starting in January.

2022-09 - 2023-08 Academic Year:

Income: \$600 from GSS, \$405.97 from the Department

Expenses: Social: \$285.53, Academic \$405.97

Projected Income: \$600-\$700 from GSS, ~\$300-\$400 from the Department

Recommendation to the Board to include as a discussion item (Maheyer Shroff):

Maheyer suggested spending some of the budget on sports, some ideas were transit for hikes, emergency supplies for the cycling club (patches)

Question (Daniel Cecchi): *Is the GSS funding guaranteed?* - Essentially yes. We apply for academic unit grants, which are guaranteed for every department and are quoted to be \$500 this year. It's guaranteed so long that we apply and can also apply for a top-up.

Follow-up Question (Daniel Cecchi): *Do we need to spend the first sum of money to get the top-up?* - When January comes around, if the GSS has money left over that was set aside for the department grants that were not used, we can apply for the top-up, but we do not need to spend the money beforehand.
