Quick Financial Review & FY2025 Grant Application

From AGM budget review:

- ~\$1300 for administrative, social, and sports events (from the GSS)
- ~\$450 for academic events (from the Department)

Spent so far this year:

- Social \$420.65
- Academic ~\$150 (research night)

Leftover:

- ~\$880 for social events including FY2025 grant, events to come are:
 - End-of-term event (EoTE)
 - Summer event
 - Sports equipment purchases
- Academic ~\$300

- Mentorship cards (<\$90)
- ~\$200 for space (initially budgeted \$280) and software plumbing (initially budgeted \$80)

Summer Meetings

- Some exec will be missing over the summer, particularly in June, when Alex, Scott, and Adrienne will be gone
- A conference here and there. Will aim for a meeting every 2 months, and have a targeted meeting for any events.
